Enclosed you will receive several

one that appears to be of a pressing nature
is an application from the District Attorney
for a special commission to try a certain person
charged with murder. I have
drawn out a blank commission which if
your Excellency should see fit to sign
I will enclose it back to me by mail
and forward it without loss of time
that the Court may be held on
14 of June. The cause that Mr. Murray
seems to think will require additional
counsel will commence in the course
of a few days & Mr. Williams the Assistant
Attorney General will assist - There has of
course been no formal order issued
directing him to aid Mr. Murray -
When the Governor & Council meet they
will agree upon the compensation
to be given to Mr. Williams.
And any thing that they may think
proper to do will I know meet with
your full approbation of that gentleman
