

on the second Monday in December in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and seventeen and eighth day of the same Month the General
Assembly of Maryland agreeably to the Constitution and Form of Government
proceeded to the choice of a Governor when His Excellency Charles Ridgely of Hamp was re-elected.

On the Tuesday following and ninth day of the same Month the General Assem-
bly made choice of the following Gentlemen as Council to the Governor to wit
Danice Murray John Stoops John Eager Howard Junior Henry A. Callis and
Arnold E. Jones Esquires.

of the Members of both Houses of the Legislature. Wm
