Therewith transmit an authenticated copy of the Presentment on which this application is grounded.

Council Chamber Annapolis November 29<sup>th</sup> 1819

Sir, Having received information that Martin Tella her, against whom, together with other persons, an Indictment has lately been found in Baltimore City Court, being the criminal Court of that City, for a conspiracy to defraud the City Bank of Baltimore, has absconded to avoid the process of the Court, and is at this time residing at Mell's Tavern on the Baltimore Road, near Richmond, it becomes my duty, under the provisions of the Law of the United States, applicable to such cases, to request that your Excellency will be pleased to cause the said Martin Tella her to be apprehended, as a fugitive from justice, and to give the Executive of this State notice thereof as soon as he shall be arrested, in order that he may be brought to answer, in a due course of Law, for the offence with which he stands charged. as the ground of this request, Therewith transmit, a duly authenticated copy of the Indictment remaining on Record in Baltimore City Court against the said Martin Tella her & others.
