I transmit to your Excellency enclosed the affidavit of Benjamin J. Cohen taken
before the Honorable Walter Denny Chief Judge of the sixth Judicial District of the State
of Maryland, on the fourth Instant, charging a certain George Bewley with the crime of forgery,
and it appearing from the said deposition and the Petition accompanying it, that
the said George W. Bewley fled from the State of Maryland from justice, and has been duly com-
mitted to the Jail of Philadelphia and is confined therein - I have in the name of the Execu-
tive Authority of the State of Maryland in virtue of the powers delegated by the constitu-
tion and law of the United States do demand of your Excellency the said George W. Bewley as
a fugitive from justice and that he be delivered to Mr. Aquila Carnoll of the City of Baltimore,
the Agent appointed by the Executive Authority of the State of Maryland to receive and
remove the said George W. Bewley to this State, having Jurisdiction of the crime of which
he is charged.
