Council Chamber Annapolis July 8 1825

I have received a demand upon the Governor of Virginia for your signature. The blank enclosed in your letter would not answer as in such cases the signature ought to be at the bottom.

I have spoken to Major Kamey and he is willing to go as agent. He mentioned that he should want a passport. I believe it is usual to allow one and if so I suppose it will be proper in this case. Indeed it appears to me to be necessary in every case. I was in possession to send on in time for the Court on Monday next. Major Kamey will be ready to start any time upon short notice, but perhaps it would be as well to defer it, until August, as otherwise difficulty might occur.

I presume the Agent will have to go to Richmond first to stand by the Virginia law authorities, the Court to deliver the prisoner as the demand is, and necessarily under the Constitution and Law of the United States must be addressed to the Governor.

I received your note by the Steam Boat and will give the same the directions you mention.

I have addressed circulars to the members of the Council requesting their attendance as Thursday the 21<sup>st</sup> inst.
