Dear Sir, The accompanying Documents from Pennsylvania being presented  
to me by Mr Garrigue the bearer hereof and agent of the Executive, and  
appearing to me sufficient to authorize the demand made by His Excellency  
Governor Shultz, I have made out the necessary papers to enable Mr Garrigue  
to obtain the prisoner and remove him to Pennsylvania when your signature  
shall be annexed for obtaining of which he visits you.

I have been looking out every mail for some time for your instructions  
about a meeting of the Council, but and yet without any. I am almost every  
day questioned upon the subject, and beg leave to request information from you  
that I may be enabled to satisfy the enquiries. Would it not be well to have  
one without much further delay?

I have received the answer of Mr Rice the Attorney  
General to my enquiries relative to subscribing for stock in the Chesapeake & Ohio  
Canal Company. It is what I presumed you clearly understood from my letter  
to you suggesting a reference of the subject to him, I anticipated that a  
legal title to stock cannot be acquired by any means in the power of the  
Executive, and he avies that nothing be attempted until the meeting of the  
Legislature.
