The enclosed is a copy of a memorial of Nicholas
M. Bosley alone of the 6th Regiment Cavalry District, which before
the close of the last Session of the Executive he urged upon their consideration.

I have examined our Military Records and find that in
the year 1823 immixtion was issued for a Sergeant and Lieutenant
of a Second Regiment in the 6th Regiment Cavalry District
and that immediately after there after the officers of all the
Troops except one belonging to the 6th Regimental District resigned
their commissions, and received new ones, attaching them to the 2nd
Regiment.

I am instructed to ask your attention to the Law upon this
subject and for your advice, what number of Troops attached to any
Regimental District will authorize the Executive to issue immixtion
to Commanding Officer of a Second Regiment? Other immixtions issued to
Commanding Officers of a Second Regiment within a Regimental District,
and they enlisted in the same man of any other than the Supernumerary
Troops belonging to the District? What are to be considered Supernumerary
Troops? When immixtion are issued to Commanding Officers of a
Second Regiment is it proper - by the Law authorize the issuing
