In reply to your communication of the 28th ultimo I am instructed
by His Excellency the Governor to inform you that upon reference to the Act of
Assembly mentioned by you and after having satisfied himself that it is still in
force, he considers that the Nolle Prosequi which he understood to grant in favor
of the Reverend Mr. Stalcup, is a forfeiture, and consequently, and in effect
void. He acted upon Mr. Stalcup's case as he supposed he was authorized
under the general power, without being aware of the prohibitory act, in cases of
prosecutions or fines. He of course expects the Court to proceed as if he had
not acted on the subject, and regrets that he incautiously attempted the exercise
of a power over its proceedings, which in such case is expressly prohibited.
