I have the pleasure in sending you herewith a commission for Major in the Regiment, under your command. The gentlemen whom you recommended for Captains you did not appoint in account of some not having stated where places they were intended to supply. To make the Executive to keep a regular list of the Officers in Commission it is necessary in all applications for appointments to state where place each person to be appointed is intended to supply, and what has become of the person to be superseded - whether dead, resigned, removed &c. This has been so much neglected in applications for appointments in the Regiment, now under your command, that no record affords satisfactory information as to the Officers actually belonging to the Regiment. I send you herewith a list of the names upon the Record, which I doubt not contains the names of several out of Commission, by death, resignation &c. If you will be pleased to cause a correct list of the Officers now actually belonging to the Regiment to be made, designating the Officers each company, and state what has become of each of those upon the list but of whom no account is given to the Regiment. I will correct the Record accordingly. For upon subsequent resignations &c. being made in the manner I have stated the Record may be kept correct.

I presume any appointment you may wish will be made at the next meeting of the Council.
