You will receive herewith a petition and some letters from a Father of William Squire in favor of a conviction of the Prisoner by the name of Blueford Carding. I saw Mr. Williams in Baltimore on Thursday last and he informed me that the Directors of the Penitentiary are anxious for Carding's release and that they had recommended him to Governor Martin full hope by death, and (the recommendation not being with them they were returned by the family of the late Governor since his death) that they would recommend him again. The card seems to be a strong one.

The orders for Messrs. Carter, Gapping and Smoot have been received. As soon as will, you deliver them. I understand that Lieut. Gapping is stationed at Philadelphia; Mr. Carter,
