

reclaiming of fugitives, from Justice requires that when a demand is made  
it shall be accompanied with a copy of an Affidavit found, or affidavit  
made charging the offence, and as Mrs Thomas has not furnished either her  
application for a demand for the fugitives in your custody cannot be complied  
with. I have written to Mrs Thomas giving her notice of what is required  
to authorize the demand, the solicitor, but I have, at the same time  
returned it to her (knowing nothing of her and fearing she may not  
get any letter from) to address this note to you explaining the cause  
of delay in making the demand, and with the hope that you may have  
in your power without inconvenience to give Mrs Thomas information  
of the evidence she must furnish before her application can succeed.
