Sir,

The General Assembly of Maryland, having authorized
the Governor to transmit to the Executive of each of the other
States and Territories of the Union, a full set of the Reports
of decisions by the Supreme Judiciary of the State by direction
of His Excellency Governor Thomas, in the course of the last
month I had deposited in the Post Office here to be sent by the
mail a full set of the said Reports for the Executive of each
State and Territory as aforesaid, directed to the Governor of each,
respectively, at the several Seats of Government. Each Volume
was put up Separately, and distinctly marked "Maryland Reports
Volume by name - Periodical."

As ~~the~~ reports intended for and directed to the
Governor of Mississippi, has been returned to the Post-office
here and upon my calling upon Mr Green to ascertain the
cause he showed me a letter addressed to him Postmaster, Nashville
T. and signed Charles Biddle, which says "It becomes my duty
to inspect the affairs of the Post-office at this place, & among other
things I found a number of bound books placed in the mail
contrary to the express order of the Post-Master General - no postage
charged upon them nor the slightest indication of the sum required
to be paid. Under ~~such~~ circumstances I have directed the volumes
to be returned to your office."

As Mr Green will address you upon this subject
I have deemed it my duty merely to put you in possession of
and respectfully request your attention to, this simple statement
of facts.
