You will find herewith enclosed, two accounts for money due the State from James S. Chew Collector of Taxes in the 2nd Election District of Prince Georges County for the year 1845 and 1846. The account for 1845 is for a balance of \$1832.76 cts with interest from 29th September 1847. That for 1846 is for a balance of \$3632.76 cts with interest from 1st October 1847.

Mr Chew by a letter dated 20th August 1848 requested that suits might be delayed until the 10th of the present month stating that "by that I (he) shall be able to make payment of a large proportion of the amount due". To this assurance he has wholly failed to comply. You will, therefore, immediately upon the receipt of the enclosed accounts, institute suits, in the most summary way against his official bonds. Please acknowledge the receipt of this.

Dear Sir,

You will find herewith enclosed sundry accounts for money due the State from collectors of Tax in Baltimore County; to wit, three accounts for money due from Jesse M. Lowe Collector in the 1st & 2nd District for the years 1844 & 1845 and in the 1st District for the year 1846. The account for 1844 is for a balance of \$1138.77 cts with interest from 2nd Oct 1847. That for 1845 is for a balance of \$3909.20 cts with interest from 2nd October 1847; and that for 1846 is for a balance of \$1619.06 cts with interest from 1st October 1847. Also three accounts for money due the State from Sellman Cox Collector in the 6th & 7th Districts for the years 1841, 1845 & 1846.

The account for 1841 is for a balance of \$392.03 cts with interest from 7th March 1844. That for 1845 is for a balance of \$1510.50 cts with interest from 1st October 1847. and that for 1846 is for the sum of \$1698.56 cts with interest from 1st October 1847 being the entire amount for that year placed in his hands for collection.

Also one account for Money due from George M. Ship Collector in the 9th & 12th District for a balance of \$6833.42 cts with interest from 1st October 1847.
