Dear Sir:

Col Merrick and Dr George, the securities in Dumbreass's official bonds as collector of State Taxes in Queen Anns County for the years 1842 and 1843 are now in Annapolis where they have come for the purpose of adjusting the balance due to the State from their principal. A very large discrepancy is, however, supposed to exist between the statement now furnished them from the Treasury, and the estimate made by you.

I am apprehensive that an error has been committed in the statement of the accounts placed in your hands, in reference to the period from which interest is to be charged. The balance due upon the accounts now made out at the Treasury and which will be shown you by these gentlemen is \$2,441.30. whereas, they are under the impression that according to your statement, there is not remaining due much, if any more, than \$1500.

The interest charged for 1842, by your statement, as understood by Col Merrick and Dr George, is \$328.75 and for 1843. \$743.02. The accounts now in their hands and before referred to, make the interest for the former year \$956.29 and for the latter \$998.05. The main purpose of these securities is to obtain a release of all interest, not actually collected, either from myself or from the Legislature at its next session.
