- 1 Gallon Measure
- 1 Two Quart do.
- 1 Quart do.
- 1 Pint Measure
- 1 Half pint do.
- 1 Half Bushel

Mr. Alexander did not deliver to me the Standard yard, and observed that the Resolution of the General Assembly did not cover it, only the weights and capacity measures being mentioned. I presume that the word "Capacity" was used inadvertently, and that all the Standards belonging to the State, were designed to be included.

I have received the three hundred dollars appropriated to which shall be in full for all the expenses incurred and the Receipts of the new scheme I have employed are enclosed.
