With this view, I would suggest the continuance of the
 Phila. to Commission, and, if possible, that Mr Wise might visit our City,
 take further to take the deposition of Witnesses who reside here.

^{testimony in} You may remark, what have I, or the State of Maryland
 the case of to do with the conviction of Citizens of Pennsylvania? To which I can only
 Mitchell. reply, that they were Mr Mitchell's agents, and acted with his Authority,
 &c. and for so doing, have been convicted and imprisoned. It might be
 that the report of the Commissioner, embodying facts, that could be
 proven, if laid before our Governor, might procure such action as
 would remove the case to a higher tribunal.

My interest in writing to you, arises from
 my having acted as Counsel for the defendants, and from the belief
 that they were wrongfully convicted. From this relationship
 to the case, I derive my knowledge, which, I will detail to
 you briefly and truthfully.
