Sir—

The Governor desires me to call your attention to the 3<sup>rd</sup> Section of the 89<sup>th</sup> Article of the Code of general laws, and to say to you that he has made enquiry of the Comptroller as therein directed, as preliminary to the commissioning of you as Notary Public at Cumberland— And the Comptroller has replied by stating that you have not reported the amount of your fees &c as Notary under former Commission; such being the case the Section above referred to will forbid the issuing of any other Commission to you as long as such default on your part exists— This report is necessary whether the fees for the year exceed the sum of \$250 or not, as otherwise the Governor can not determine as he is required by the above Section to do, before issuing a Commission that "all the requirements of the Constitution and laws have been complied with."

The duty of a Notary to which your attention is now particularly called, is prescribed in Sections 22, 24 & 25 of Article 38 Code General Laws.
