A Statement of the Counties and other Divisions constituting the several Congressional Districts of the State of Maryland as arranged by an Act of the General Assembly at January Session 1862 Ch. 228

1st Congressional District Composed of the Counties of Worcester, Somerset, Dorchester, Talbot, Caroline, Queen Anne's, Kent and Cecil.

2nd

Composed of the County of Harford, the 5th, 6th, 7th, 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th Districts of Baltimore County and the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th and 7th Wards of Baltimore City.

3rd

Composed of the Wards of Baltimore City from the 8th to the 20th inclusive.
