

the Western Section of the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal, before the completion of the Eastern Section thereof; provided that such commencement be not made without the special agreement of the Stockholders, expressed in a general meeting, called to consider the expediency thereof, or in one of the annual meetings of the Company.

Resolved, That if it shall be the opinion of the President and Directors, that they are not authorized by the charter of the Company to charge wharfage upon such vessels and boats as may lie at the wharves and moles constructed at the expense of the Company on the basin at Rock creek, they be empowered and instructed to ask of the Congress of the United States such authority; provided, that no wharfage be chargeable on any canal boat which is on its passage through the basin, or on any canal boat which does not deliver the whole or part of her cargo thereat, or which does not remain in the said basin more than forty-eight hours.

The meeting then adjourned to 10 o'clock to-morrow morning.
