



Suppose the line A, E, F, B, in figure first to represent the route of the Rail Road, and the line C, E, F, D, that of the Canal, it will be seen, that they are in collision from E to F, and consequently, as they both cannot pass along the identical same route, either the road must pursue the course E, G, F, or the Canal, must be directed along the line E, H, F, a map or plot may sufficiently exhibit the mere horizontal extent of these deviations from the route claimed by either party.
