To his Excellency,

**THOMAS KING CARROLL,**

Governor of Maryland.

Sir,—I have the honor to transmit to your Excellency, the enclosed abstract of the proceedings of the Maryland Penitentiary, during the nine months ending on the 30th November last, accompanied by a summary of an inventory and a general account of Stock taken by direction of the Board at the commencement of that period by the Executive Committee. The latter exhibits a decrease of the nett amount Stock during the first quarter of this year, of 5,322 72—caused as reported by the Committee, “by the difference in the valuation of the goods on hand and the depreciation and decay of the various implements in general use”

The former presents a nett gain for the nine months comprising the service of the present Board \$9,638 66 (or inclusive of the annual instalment on the loan of 1822, of \$10,638 66.) The difference between these amounts, \$4,315 54 forms the gain of the whole year, after defray-
