The report of the Trustees of the University of Maryland, respectfully represents,—

That in the Faculty of Physic, a vacancy has happened by the lamented death of John D. Wells, Professor of Anatomy. Benjamin Lincoln, M. D. has been appointed, in his place, Professor of Anatomy, pro tempore.

During the past season Professor De Butts went to Europe to procure additional apparatus for the chair of Chemistry; and that opportunity was availed of, for the purpose of purchasing a philosophical apparatus for the Faculty of Arts and Sciences.

Since the last annual report, great efforts have been made to bring into full operation and activity the Faculty of Arts and Sciences; and many new Professors have been appointed, that is to say,—Julius T. Ducatel, Professor of Chemistry; Joshua J. Cohen, Professor of Mineralogy applied to the Arts, and Geology; George Frick, Professor of Natural History; Edward Hinkley, Professor of Mathematics; Charles S.
