The Treasurer of the Western Shore, in obedience to their order of the 28th ult, "that he report the expenses incurred in making the Geographical and Geological surveys of the State," submits the following statement-

The payments made from the Treasury for account of the Geographical surveys of the State, on the 12th January, 1838, (as shewn in detail, by his Report of that date to the Houorable House of last year, to which he asks leave to refer) had a-\$13,100 24 mounted to the sum of

And to that amount should have been added, as appears by the Topographical Engineer's Report of the 15th Feb. 1838, to the same House, the other half of the payment made 18th March, 1837,
