

Fund, into 5 per cent Stock of the State as directed by ch. 299 of the acts of Dec. session, 1834, and by an authentic certificate, that on the 1st Dec 1838, there remained to his credit as Treasurer, in the Union Bank of Maryland, of the said special deposite, the sum of \$32,407 85 cents.

That it appear to your Committee, there remains in the Treasury, as 1st Dec. 1838, to the credit of the said Free Schools Fund, a balance in cash, of twenty eight thousand nine hundred and fifty dollars and twenty one cents—and this sum too, they find stands to his credit as Treasurer, in the Farmers Bank of Maryland.
