The land occupied by the above extent of Canal (21 miles, 1242 yds) Route will be about 325 acres. The land occupied by the feeders will amount to about 108 acres. The land occupied by the Reservoirs, allowing 10 feet beyond the high water, will amount to 1753 acres—making a total of 2186 acres.

A great number of mill sites will be destroyed which we have no means of estimating.

The soiling of the slopes and the fencing are likewise omitted.
