

98 An act to condemn and lay off a lot of ground for a public landing on a certain farm called Brittons Bay, in St. Mary's county, and make public a road therein mentioned.

99 A further additional supplement to an act, entitled, an act to incorporate a company for the purpose of cutting and making a canal between the river Delaware and the Chesapeake bay.

100 An act for the relief of Monica, a free negro of Montgomery County.

101 An act better to define and prescribe the power and duties of the Levy Court and Trustee's of the Poor of Worcester County.

102 An additional supplement to an act, entitled an act for the appointment of Commissioners for the regulation and improvement of Cambridge, in Dorchester County, and to establish and regulate the market in said Town.

103 An act to authorize Caleb White, Collector of Taxes in the second collection district of Anne Arundel County, further time to complete his collection.

104 An act to divorce Sarah F. Patterson, of the City of Baltimore, from her husband Henry P. Patterson.

105 A further supplement to an act, entitled an act to provide for the relief and support of the poor and indigent persons of Worcester County, passed at December session 1835.

106 An act for the relief of Alexander A. Howard.

107 A supplement to an act for the relief of Samuel G. Holbrook, late Sheriff of Somerset County.

108 An act relating to the compensation, payable by officers, to the Sheriff of Harford County, for collecting officer's fees.

109 An act to provide for the election of Commissioners for Somerset County, and to enlarge their powers and duties.

110 An act to divorce Mary Ann Todd of Harford County, from her husband, John F. Todd.

111 An act to authorize Romulus R. Griffith, to remove into this State, a negro slave for life.

112 An act authorizing the School House Building Committee of Sharpsburg, in Washington County, to sell and convey a lot therein mentioned.

113 An act to authorize Thomas M. D. Baden, Collector of Taxes for Prince George's County, further time to complete his collections.

114 An act to protect the reputation of unmarried Women.

115 An act to divorce Rebecca Barron, of Prince George's County, from her husband Samuel Barron.

116 An act to allow Ann Camden, to bring into this State, certain slaves.

117 An act for the relief of Isaac Gibbons.

118 A supplement to the Charter of the United Beneficial Society of Cordwainers, of the City of Baltimore.

119 An act to authorize Samuel S. Cunningham of Washington County, to bring into this State, a certain Negro Slave therein mentioned.
