

- 184 An act for the relief of Noble Nesbit.
- 185 An act to divorce Mary Wills, of Dorchester county, from her husband David C. Wills.
- 186 An act to divorce James H. Knotts, of Queen Anne's county, from his wife Catharine Knotts.
- 187 An act to divorce Mary Ann Rector, of the city of Baltimore, from her husband George Rector.
- 188 A supplement to an act entitled an act. to lay out and open a road from the town of Westminster, in Frederick. (now in Carroll county) to the city of Washington, and George town.
- 189 An act to divorce John Piercy of the city of Baltimore, from his wife Mary Piercy.
- 190 An act entitled an act releasing the interest of the State, to the lands which may have escheated to the State, by the death of the Reverend Timothy Ryan, a Clergyman of the Roman Catholic Church, late of Washington county.
- 191 An act to provide for the establishment of district schools in Charles county.
- 192 An act to encourage the growth of the Mulberry, and the raising of silk, at the Arms, and Work House, of Montgomery county.
- 193 An act to authorize James J. Fisher, to bring into this State of Maryland from Virginia, a negro slave for life.
- 194 An act to authorize the commissioners of Baltimore county to build a bridge over the great falls of Gunpowder where the county road leading from Middletown to the falls road, crosses said falls in Baltimore county.
- 195 An act to incorporate the Friendship society of Baltimore.
- 196 An act relating to the building of certain bridges in Harford county.
- 197 An act for draining a prong of the Andover branch, commonly called D. ford's branch.
- 198 An act to incorporate a high school in the city of Baltimore.
- 199 An act to incorporate the Beonsborough Beneficial Society.
- 200 An act to authorize the commissioners of Cecil county to levy a sum of money for the purpose of rebuilding a bridge over the Octorara creek in said county, at or near Porter's Mill.
- 201 An act entitled, a further supplement to the act of 1826, chapter 217. and the several supplements thereto, in relation to the electing commissioners for Baltimore county.
- 202 An act authorizing the commissioners of the tax of Carroll county to levy a certain sum of money therein mentioned.
- 203 An act to divorce Dorcas A. Roach, from her husband John J. Roach.
- 204 An act to provide for the public instruction of youth in Allegany county.
- 205 An act relating to the lien of Mechanics, and others upon buildings.
