

268 An act to revive the 12th, 13th, 14th and 15th sections of an act, passed December session, 1815, chapter 166, entitled, an act to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road, from the Frederick and Baltimore turnpike road, commencing at the West end of Frederick Town to Harpers Ferry on the Potomac River.

269 A further supplement to an act, entitled, an act relating to the people of colour in this State, passed at December session, 1831, chapter 281, so far as the same relates to Frederick county:
