In 1839 the treasurer was authorised to pay to the directors, or their order, \$30,000, in three equal annual payments.

Two drafts upon the treasurer, payable in 1840 and 1841, (drawn in pursuance of the authority thus given) have been negotiated; the net proceeds of which amounted to \$18,485 22, which has gone to the increase of the active capital of the institution.

No part of the said appropriations was applied to the improvement of the real estate.
