82. An act to incorporate the Independent Hose Company of Frederick.
83. An act to protect the lives of persons travelling on rail roads within the State of Maryland.
84. An act to divorce Eliza Ann Redding of the city of Baltimore, from her husband, James Piper Redding.
85. An act for the benefit of the infant children of the late Daniel Clarke.
86. An act to provide for the payment of State witnesses in Baltimore county.
87. An act for the relief of Theodore R. Lockerman of Talbot county.
88. An act to repeal an act to authorise an alteration in the location of the public road from the city of Annapolis to the city of Baltimore, through the lands of Leonard Iglehart, John T. Hodges, Nicholas B. Worthington, and Absalom Bealmear and wife, passed at December session 1839, chapter 163.
89. An act to incorporate the town of Frostburg in Allegany county.
90. A supplement to an act, entitled, an act to establish magistrates' courts in the several counties of this State, and to prescribe their jurisdiction; passed December session 1835, chapter 201.
91. An act in behalf of John Whiteside of Montgomery county.
92. An act for the benefit of the children of James Power of the city of Baltimore.
93. An act to provide for making and keeping an index of the judgments that may hereafter be rendered in Montgomery county court, or that may be rendered by magistrates' courts or single justices of the peace, when the same may be made liens upon the land by complying with the law relating thereto.
