

138. An act to authorize and empower Sarah Murray, widow and administratrix of John Murray, late of Baltimore county deceased, to execute a certain conveyance therein mentioned.

139. An additional supplement to an act, entitled, an act to introduce wholesome water in the city of Frederick.

140. An act in aid of building of an Academy in Frostburg and a Market house and town hall over it, in Cumberland, Allegany county.

141. A supplement to an act, entitled, an act to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road from Hagerstown in Washington county to the Pennsylvania line, passed at Dec. session 1835, chap. 321.

142. An act for the incorporation of the Mechanics Circulating Library Society of the town of Cumberland, Maryland.

143. An act to authorize the closing of part of an alley in Hagerstown.

144. An act incorporating the Deer creek improving Company.

145. An act to authorize the drawing of a Lottery for the benefit of female education.

146. An act to extend the jurisdiction of single justices of the peace for Cecil county and for other purposes.

147. An act to aid in the establishment of a Female Seminary in Frederick city.

148. An additional supplement to an act to provide for the public instruction of youth in primary schools throughout this State, passed December session 1837, chap. 206, so far as relates to Dorchester county.

149. A supplement to an act, entitled, an act to authorize the commissioners of Cecil county to levy a sum of money to build a bridge over little Elk creek in Cecil county, passed at Dec. session 1837, ch. 111.

153. An act empowering the commissioners of Washington county to build a bridge across Antietam creek, at or near Clagett's Mill.

154. An act to authorize Allegany county court to ratify and confirm a sale made by Moses Rawling late sheriff of Allegany county to Wm. Right and Jefferson M. Price of certain real estate.

155. An act entitled, a further supplement to an act, entitled, an act, relating to free negroes and slaves.

156. An act extending the time of completing the Turnpike Road from Boonsborough in Washington county to Swearingen's ferry on the Potomac river.
