

If the Legislature should determine to redeem the scrip which has been issued by the late President and Directors of the company, and in which the tolls of the company are now generally paid, the tolls would then become available and might be applied to meet the contingent expenses of the company—should this not be done, the undersigned would respectfully suggest that such an appropriation should be made at the present session of the Legislature, as may be necessary to defray the current expenses of the work.

Desiring to place in your possession the information contained in our report, before the adjournment of your honorable body, and anticipating the close of your session at an early day, we have confined our attention to those points which recurred to us to require your notice and have deferred a further examination into the affairs of the company, until the next general meeting of the stockholders.
