ON THE REPORT OF THE TREASURER OF THE WESTERN SHORE.

BY THE COMMITTEE OF CLAIMS.

Your committee report, that they have examined the proceedings and documents of George Mackubin, Treasurer of the Western Shore of Maryland, and find from an account settled to 1st December 1840, by the Committee of Claims of the last General Assembly, there then remained in the Treasury fifty-eight thousand four hundred and fourteen dollars and eighty-six cents.
