217. An act for the relief of Sarah Henrietta Mays of Anne Arundel county.

218. An act for the establishment of a public landing and wharf at Green landing in Prince George's county.

219. An act to repeal an act entitled, an act to authorise the Banks of the State of Maryland to receive and pay out the orders drawn by the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road Company, on the stock of the city of Baltimore, and for other purposes.

220. An act for the benefit of the heirs of Rezin Gaither, deceased.

221. An act to provide for the inspection of lumber, at Havre De Grace.

222. An act providing for the hearing and decision at the first term of the Court of Appeals of the case therein mentioned.

223. An act for the benefit of James Carroll, of Talbot county.

224. An act to allow Joseph Graham, former sheriff of Talbot county, further time to complete his collections.
