Which added to the amount on hand, makes 10,068 hhds., of which were shipped, during the month of January, 1843, 2,807 hhds., as follows:

Which being deducted from the amount of 10,068 hogsheads, leaves on hand, the 1st February, 1843, 7,661 hogsheads in all the warehouses, and making the amount of shipments from the 1st of January, 1842, to the 1st of February, 1843, 47,644 hogsheads.
