

REPORT.

BY THE COMMITTEE OF CLAIMS.

Your Committee report that, they have examined the proceedings and documents of George Mackubin as Treasurer of the Western Shore, from 1st Dec. 1842 (the beginning of the last fiscal year) to 9th March, 1843 (the day on which he was superceded) and they find from an account settled by the Committee of Claims of the last General Assembly, to the said 1st Dec. 1842, that there then remained in the Treasury, a balance of fifty-eight thousand eight hundred and fifty-eight dollars and twenty-three cents.

That it appears to your Committee by the accounts of the said Treasurer, that he received from the said 1st Dec. 1842 to the said 9th March, 1843, inclusive, one hundred and eighty three thousand one hundred and seventy-five dollars and fifty-six cents, viz:
