That it appears to your committee the said Treasurer has disbursed in the same time the sum of fifty-eight thousand and ninety-eight dolars, viz:

On account of the Free Schools' Fund, he paid to certain counties &c. as set forth in the accompanying account current,
On account of the Sinking Fund he paid and invested,

\$57,180 50

\$58,098 00

For all of which payments and investments he has presented to your committee satisfactory vouchers.

That it appears to your committee there remains in the Treasury as of 1st December 1843, to the credit of the Free Schools Fund, a balance in cash of twenty-six thousand and fifteen dollars, and ninety-seven cents—and this sum too, they find stands to his credit as Treasurer, in the Farmers' Bank of Maryland.
