In the amount of receipts stated above, are not included the tolls collected on products descending the Canal from the Conestoga, as they form a separate item of account with the Conestoga Company, who have not yet furnished their accounts for the year. We are therefore unable to state the precise amount but estimate it at about \$2500. Making an actual increase of tolls over last year of \$5,133 72, as stated in the communication.
