

That it appears to your committee, the said late Treasurer disbursed in the same time the sum of twelve thousand four hundred and sixteen dollars and sixty one cents, viz :

On account of the Free Schools Fund, he paid to or invested for certain counties &c., as set forth in the accompanying account current, - - -	\$9,863 99
And on account of the Sinking Fund, he paid and invested, - - - - -	2,552 62
	\$12,416 61

For all which payments and investments he has presented to your committee satisfactory vouchers.

That it appears to your committee, there remained in the treasury as of the 11th January, 1844, to the credit of the said funds a balance in cash of nineteen thousand and eighty-seven dollars and fifty-eight cents, and this sum, they find, likewise stood on that day to his credit as treasurer in the Farmers' Bank of Maryland, and which was duly paid over by him to D. Claude, Esq., the present treasurer, and for which payment he has produced to your committee a satisfactory voucher.
