INTERROGATORIES.

Ordered, That the President of the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company, be required to communicate to this House at the earliest practicable period,

1st. The names of all such individuals, if any, as have been employed or authorised to be employed by said company, together with the amount of compensation paid to, allowed or claimed by such individuals during December sessions 1841, 1842 and 1843, of the General Assembly, together with the services stipulated to be rendered by such individuals during the said several sessions of the General Assembly.

2nd. Whether the said company have employed or intend employing any individual, whether an officer, or agent of the company, or counsel, to attend the present session of the General Assembly, and if so, the names of such persons, the services stipulated for, and the amount of compensation offered or demanded.
