BY THE COMMITTEE ON CLAIMS.

Your Committee report, that they have examined the proceedings and Documents of D. Claude, Treasurer of Maryland, and find from an account settled to 1st December 1844, by the Committee of Claims of the last General Assembly, there then remained in the Treasury, one hundred and eighty-one thousand, two hundred and seventy-two dollars.

That it appears to your Committee by the accounts of the said Treasurer, he has received from 1st December 1844, to 1st December 1845, \$966,589, viz : on the following accounts :
