To the Honorable,

The House of Delegates:

The Treasurer in accordance with the order of the House of the 8th instant, has the honor to submit the accompanying tables,

marked No. 1, and 2.

No. 1, exhibits the amount of Direct Taxes apportioned to each County, Baltimore City and Howard District, for the years 1841, 1842, 1843, 1844 and 1845, and also the amount paid into the Treasury, by each County, Howard District and the city of Baltimore, in each of the years 1842, 1843 and 1844. No portion of the Tax was paid in 1841, and but one quarter of the tax of 1845, is yet payable into the Treasury.

No. 2, gives the amount which has been placed in the hands of each Collector, whose account at this time remains unsettled with

the Treasury.

It shews also the amount of his allowances and payments and the balance still due by him on account of the taxes for each year for which he is collector.
