

Inheritances, Distributive Shares and Legacies, to aid in paying the debts of the State.

203. A further additional supplement to the act entitled an act for the general valuation and assessment of property in this State, and to provide a tax to pay the debts of the State, passed at March Session 1841, chapter 23.

204. An act to incorporate the agricultural Society of Somerset county.

205. An act for the Incorporation of Marion Division No. 19, of the Sons of Temperance of the State of Maryland.

206. An act to incorporate Uncas Tribe number six, of the improved order of Red Men of the State of Maryland.

207. An act to compel the commissioners appointed by the act of eighteen hundred and thirty-three, chapter 156, to account to the levy court of Prince George's county.

208. An act directing the commissioners of Somerset county to publish annually a correct statement of their receipts and expenditures.

209. An additional supplement to an act to provide a summary mode of recovering the possession of lands and tenements held by tenants for years or at will, after the expiration of their terms, passed at November session, 1793, chapter 43.

210. An act to authorise the Governor of Maryland to appoint an Inspector of Flour for the town of Cumberland.

211. An act to repeal all laws granting out pensions in Cecil county, and authorising the county commissioners in said county to grant out pensions in such cases as in their judgment the parties for whom the same is to be levied shall stand in actual need of support by county assessment.

212. An act relating to the streets in, and the public roads in the vicinity of Chestertown.

213. An act to authorise and empower John C. Bryan, of Queen Ann's county to complete the collections of Thomas W. Decoursey, late collector of said county and to give him further time so to do.

214. An act ceding to the United States jurisdiction into, and over Sollers Point Flats in the Patapsco river, whenever the United States shall acquire the title to the same from the owner or owners thereof.

215. An act ceding to the United States jurisdiction over the sites of Forts Madison and Severn.

216. A supplement to the act to regulate the issuing of licenses to traders, keepers of ordinances and others, passed at December session, 1827, chapter 117, and imposing a tax on brokers for the sale of merchandize.

217. An act authorising the commissioners of Cecil county to cause a re-assessment of the real estate of Henry H. Gilpin, of said county, to be made by such assessor as they may appoint.
