

259. An act to incorporate the Hagerstown Horse Guards, in Washington county.

260. An act relating to the Commercial and Farmers' Bank of Baltimore.

261. A supplement to the act of 1831, chapter 316, entitled an act relating to Insolvent Debtors.

262. An act to incorporate the Patapsco Division, number 11, of the Sons of Temperance, of the State of Maryland.

263. An act for the relief of William McCullough, late sheriff of Cecil county.

264. An act for the extension of the time of William Nevitt, collector of Charles county, for the payment of the direct and income tax.

265. An act entitled, a further supplement to an act, passed at December session, 1838, chapter 362, entitled, an act appointing and regulating Primary Schools, in Saint Mary's county.

266. A supplement to the act entitled, an act to prevent the destruction of Wild Fowl in the head waters of the Chesapeake Bay, in the several counties therein mentioned, passed at December session, 1837, chapter 10; also, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to preserve the Ducks in Sassafras, Elk and Bohemia river, passed at December session, 1843, chapter 302.

276. An act to authorise Rebecca Shenton of Calvert county, to convey a certain piece of land therein mentioned.
