Received from the Treasurer of Maryland, and receipted for certificates of Stock of the State standing in his official name, and to his credit on the books of the State's Loan Officer in Baltimore, amounting together to the sum of two hundred and seventeen thousand one hundred and eighty-seven dollars, \$217,187 00, purchased by him in augmentation of the Sinking Fund from the 11th of January, 1844, to the 1st December, 1846, which said Stock are of the following issues, amounts and denominations, viz :

per cent. Stock certificate, No. 6684 for \$136,730 00, being like proceeds from conversion of 113 bonds of £250 each,	136,730 00
per cent. Stock certificate No. 6683 for \$36,300, being like proceeds from conversion of 15 bonds of £500 each,	36,300 00
