60. A supplement to an act defining the powers of the mayor and commissioners of Hager's city, passed at December session, 1847, chapter 198.

61. An act to authorise the commissioners of Washington county to levy a sum of money for the purpose of purchasing and providing a farm for the better and more economical support of the poor of Washington county.

62. An act to allow Benjamin Swingley, former collector of taxes in Washington county, further time to complete his collections.

63. An act supplementary to an act, passed at December session, 1842, chapter 214.

64. An act to divorce Augusta M. Taylor, of the city of Baltimore, from her husband Marcellus K. Taylor.

65. An act empowering the mayor and city council of Baltimore to alter certain alleys and streets on Whetstone Point.

66. An act to make valid a certain deed of mortgage from John H. Burchenal and wife to James A. Pearce.
