328. An act supplemental to the several acts relating to the powers and duties of the Board of Primary Education of Worcester county.

329. A supplement to an act passed at December session 1845, chapter 245, entitled an act to authorise the commissioners of Harford county to levy a sum of money, at their discretion, to build a bridge over Winter's run at the Ring Factory.
