

# R E P O R T.

## BY THE COMMITTEE OF CLAIMS.

Your Committee report that they have examined the proceedings and documents of D. Claude, as Treasurer of Maryland, from 1st December 1851, (the beginning of the fiscal year,) to 24th February 1852, (the day on which he was superceded,) and they find, from an account settled by the Committee of Claims of the present General Assembly, to 1st December 1851, that there then remained in the Treasury a balance of two hundred and fifty thousand nine hundred and fifty-seven dollars and seventy-two cents, (250,957.72.)

That it appears to your Committee, by the accounts of the said Treasurer, that he received, from the said 1st December 1851, to the said 24th February 1852, inclusive, one hundred and eighty-eight thousand five hundred and sixty-four dollars and sixty-eight cents, (\$188,564.68,) viz :
