

125. An act entitled, a supplement to an act to preserve the breed of fish, and to regulate and protect fishing on the Potomac river and its tributaries during certain months, and concerning obstructions to fishing in said river, passed at December session, 1843.

126. An act to amend an act entitled, an act authorising the Commissioners of Washington county to lay off a new election district in Washington county, and the polls to be held at Sandy Hook, passed March 24, 1852.

127. An act to refund to Richard C. Hollyday, late Clerk of Cecil County Court, an overpayment made by him into the Treasury.

128. An act entit'ed, an act to authorise the County Commissioners for Frederick county to purchase an index to land records for said county.

129. An act entitled, a supplement to an act for the preservation and repair of that part of the United States road lying within the limits of Maryland, passed at December session, 1831, chapter 65.

130. An act to refund to Rev'd Nicholas I. Watkins thirty-two dollars and seventy-three cents, being the amount overpaid the State by said Watkins for State taxes.

131. An act to incorporate the Merchants' Exchange Company of Baltimore.

132. An act to allow to the Susquehanna and Tide Water Canal Companies to fund their debt and issue additional stock.

133. An act to provide that the answers of defendants in proceedings in equity shall not be evidence against complainants, unless such answers be required by the complainants to be under oath.

134. An act to require advertisements proceeding from the Courts and officers of Baltimore county to be published in one paper printed in the said county.

135. An act appropriating a sum of money to pay for repairs made in and materials furnished for the Senate Chamber.

136. An act to make valid all judgments rendered by any of the District Courts of this State since the adoption of the new constitution.

137. An act to incorporate the Mutual Fire Insurance Company of Anne Arundel county.

138. An act relating to sales by public auction in the town of Elkton and the other incorporated towns in Cecil county.

139. An act to fix the per diem of the Judges of the Orphans' Court of Baltimore city and of the Judges of the Orphans' Court of Baltimore county, pursuant to the seventeenth section of the fourth article of the constitution.

140. An act requiring the Judges of the first judicial circuit of Maryland to suppress the retailing of ardent spirits in the village
