141. An act to authorise the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to aid in the construction of a rail road from the terminus of the York and Cumberland road, at Bridgeport, to Sunbury and Williamsport on the Susquehanna.

142. An act to authorise the Commissioner of the Land Office to issue a warrant of resurvey and patent for certain lands in Allegany county.

143. An act to amend an act entitled, an act to incorporate the proprietors of Baltimore Cemetery, passed at December session, 1849, chapter 71, granting power to said company to convey certain portions of their grounds, and to increase its capital stock.

144. An act to authorise the County Commissioners of Frederick county, in their discretion, from time to time, to appoint road Commissioners to examine and report upon the best means of improving the road leading from Frederick Town through Hamburg to the Washington county line, and to take steps to improve said road.

145. An act to amend an act entitled, an act to incorporate the Mutual Insurance Company of Frederick County, passed at December session, 1843, chapter 191.

146. An act giving certain powers to the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore in regard to the North Western Virginia Rail Road.

147. A further additional supplement to the act passed December session, 1838, chapter 191, entitled, an act to provide for the establishment of district schools in Charles county.

148. An act authorising the incorporation of Homestead or Building Associations in this State.

149. An act authorising the County Commissioners of Allegany county to appropriate annually a sufficient sum of money to pay State's

151. An act relating to the Maryland Penitentiary, and appropriating a sum of money therein named.

152. An act to regulate the inspecting of domestic distilled liquors in this State.
